(Regulation 12)

DECLARATION OF RENUNCIATION OF CITIZENSHIP UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE ACT MADE BY A CITIZEN OF GUYANA WHO IS OR IS ABOUT TO BECOME A CITIZEN OF ONE OF THE COUNTRIES TO WHICH ARTICLE 27 OF THE CONSTITUTION APPLIES\* OR OF THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND OR A NATIONAL OF A FOREIGN COUNTRY.
